

# OverDrive Nook Tip Sheet

## Connect to WiFi

1. Wake up the Nook or turn on.
2. Slide Nook symbol to the right to unlock
3. Tap white Nav Arrow in Status Bar to display Quick Nav Bar
4. Tap Settings Icon
5. Tap Wireless
6. Make sure WiFi is on.
7. Tap Wi-Fi hotspot—enter password/key

## Check Out and Download Book on Nook

- Open a web browser on computer/laptop.
- Select an available title and add it to you cart.
- Proceed to checkout
  - Enter your library system (Arrowhead)
  - Enter your library card number and PIN
  - Checkout out the item
  - Click on the Download button (large green button)

## Download book to Nook

- Adobe Digital Editions will open up.
  - The title you checked out will appear
  - Plug the Nook into the computer using the USB cable
  - Confirm that you are in Library View in the upper left corner
  - The Nook will appear in the menu under Recently Read
  - Click on title and drag it to the Nook.

## Disconnect Nook

- Click on the Safely Remove Hardware icon on the task bar
- When you receive message that hardware can safely be removed, disconnect the cable.

## View Title on the Nook

- Tap the Library icon
- Select My Files
- Tap Digital Editions
- Tap book cover
- Begin reading

## Delete Downloaded titles from Nook

- Plug in the Nook to the computer with the USB cable
- Open Adobe Digital Editions
- Select the Nook
- Make sure you are in Library View
- Only delete titles with a banner across the corner of the book
- Move the cursor over the title
- Note the small arrow that appears in the upper left corner of the book cover
- Click on the arrow for options
- If item hasn't expired, choose Return borrowed item
- If item has expired, choose Delete item
- Eject Nook from computer
