

Sharpie Tie-Dye

- 1. Smooth a section of your shirt (one layer) over a plastic cup.**
- 2. Secure it with a rubber band.**
- 3. Use a Sharpie to form a circle/ring in the center of the area formed by the cup. You can use more than one color. Your circle should be about one inch across. This is one inch:**
- 4. Using a pipette, drip rubbing alcohol in the middle of the circle. After a few drops, the alcohol will spread outward, taking the ink with it.**
- 5. Continue adding drops until you are satisfied with the size of the pattern.**
- 6. Move on to a clean section of the shirt, and repeat steps 1-5.**
- 7. Try designs other than circles! Hearts, stars, squares. . . be creative!**

At-Home Instructions

Make sure your shirt is completely dry.

Set the colors by tumbling the shirt in a hot clothes dryer for 15 minutes.

You can wear and wash your shirt like other clothes!
