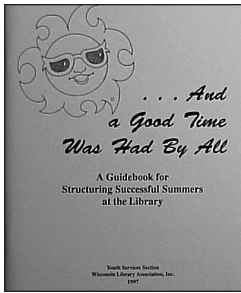

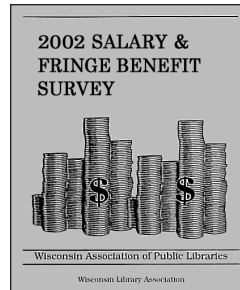
PUBLICATION DESCRIPTION
